All participants will ride in Sunday's friendly competition, followed by lunch and the awards presentation. There will be a \$25 (additional) cattle charge per entry for the Clint Weaver cattle clinic for riders not enrolled in all 5 weekends.

All clinics & competitions will begin at 9 a.m. Lunch each day is included. Auditing/spectating is \$10 & includes lunch, reservations are appreciated.

HDHC * GENERAL RULES

- 1. Past winners of the "novice" division (riding the same horse) must advance to "open".**
- 2. Contestants who professionally train horses, give riding lessons or similar equine instruction for pay; or compete in equine activities as an advanced, open or professional rider must participate in the "open" division.**
- 3. Contestants riding in the "OPEN" division must ride in the "Intermediate" or "Advanced" levels in the trail trial, western dressage and/or any other competition involving a choice of "tests".**
- 4. There must be at least three contestants in each division. If not, riders will be moved up to the next division. E.g., should there be less than three contestants in the "open" division, they will ride in the "novice" division but be judged as "advanced".**
- 5. Any disputes, (judging or otherwise), must be taken up with the challenge officials before the end of the day.**
- 6. Contestants riding for a series "overall" award must ride the same horse in all five weekends. If the horse becomes ill or injured, the rider may substitute another horse upon presentation of a letter signed by a veterinarian stating type of injury/illness and expected date of recovery.**
- 7. If there are less than three qualifying riders in a division, any rider who has participated on 4 weekends will be eligible for an "overall" award.**
- 8. Riding helmets are mandatory for any rider under the age of 18. They are optional for riders 18 and over.**
- 9. The dress code will be as follows: for the clinic, contestants must wear long pants and appropriate riding shoes (with a minimum 1/2" heel). On the day of the show, they also must wear a long sleeved shirt (tucked in) and a western hat or riding helmet.**
- 10. Any type of tack (Western or English) may be used. A saddle and bridle, bosal or hackamore are required.**
- 11. Excessive use/abuse of crops, whips or spurs may cause penalties and/or disqualification at the judge's discretion.**
- 12. Contestants will not be allowed to bring stallions onto the premises nor ride them in the competition.**
- 13. All contestants, their family members and/or traveling companions are expected to display good sportsmanship at all times. Foul language and/or displays of poor sportsmanship, verbal abuse or harassment of any show official, volunteer or participant will not be tolerated and may result in disqualification from the event.**
- 14. A contestant's "bounced" check will result in a \$25 service fee. Failure of the contestant to cover the check and pay the service fee will result in disqualification from the HDHC.**
- 15. The use of alcohol during the event is prohibited, and may result in disqualification.**
- 16. There will be no refunds upon disqualification.**
- 17. It is the responsibility of the rider to know and understand the rules**
- 18. Rules are subject to change.**

OTHER STUFF.....

- * All entries are accepted by postmark (or date received if hand delivered.)**
- * Entry fees are non-refundable unless the spot reserved for you has been filled.**
- * Should an event be at maximum capacity, a waiting list will be established.**
- * We do our very best to accommodate clinic date requests. Flexibility is appreciated.**
- * If your dog must accompany you, please leave sweet Fido at the trailer & on a leash. This is for the safety & well being of your pet, clinic participants, horses & livestock.**
