# Trail Trial

## BROKEN BIT RANCH GENERAL RULES

Youth, 18-49, & 50-64, 65+ divisions include Novice, Intermediate, and Advanced.

Riders are responsible for handing their scorecards in to registration after completing the course.

There will be 10 obstacles to test the rider's knowledge and horse's abilities.

Obstacles can be done in any order.

Obstacles will be natural and unnatural.

Safety and common sense are the number one priority.

Any attire normally worn for trail riding is accepted. Long pants are a must, shorts will not be allowed. Helmets are encouraged.

Appropriate riding footwear is required (no sneakers, sandals or bare feet).

Any type of tack may be used, a saddle and bridle (or bosal or hackamore) are a must!

Halter, lead rope, knife and hoof pick are required equipment

The course is to be completed on horseback. Rider's may not be ponied or ride double.

Horse must be lead by a halter/lead rope, halter-bridle combo unclipped from the reins, or bosal and mecate.

The rider must have the judge's attention before starting the obstacle.

The judge reserves the right to ask horse and rider to move onto the next obstacle if he/she feels an unsafe situation has arisen or after 3 tries!

*Voice commands are permitted, along with aids to cue your horse (such as crops and spurs), excessive use/abuse may cause penalties and/or disqualification at the judges discretion.*

Any judging disputes must be taken to the event officials. Any discussion of the scores with the obstacle judge will disqualify the rider for that obstacle.

Foul language and/or displays of poor sportsmanship, verbal abuse or harassment of any show official or participant will not be tolerated and may result in disqualification from the event.

Obstacles will be available for schooling after the last rider has gone through. If you would like to school an obstacle before the ride is completed, please wait until all waiting riders have had their turn, then ask the judge if it is ok to school your horse on the obstacle.

**ABSOLUTELY NO COACHING IS ALLOWED!**

Once trial has begun (10 a.m.) there will be no refunds!

It is the responsibility of the rider to know and understand the rules.
